Residential Parking Permits expire June 30, 2009. The Borough Clerk's office will begin issuing 2009-2010 permits on June 16th. Applicants for permits shall be required to present proof of residence fronting on the streets in the areas designated as preferential parking zones. These permits are free of charge, courtesy of Mayor & Council. The parking decal is to be displayed in the left lower corner of the rear window- the side window is not acceptable.

Senior Citizen Parking Permits expire July 31, 2009. The Borough Clerk's office will begin issuing 2009-2010 permits on July 14th. These parking permits, for designated areas of Lot 2 (Chestnut St. and E. Grant Ave.) may be used by Senior Citizens while attending Casano Center activities. These permits are also free of charge, courtesy of Mayor & Council and must be displayed in the lower left corner of the rear window-the side window is not acceptable.

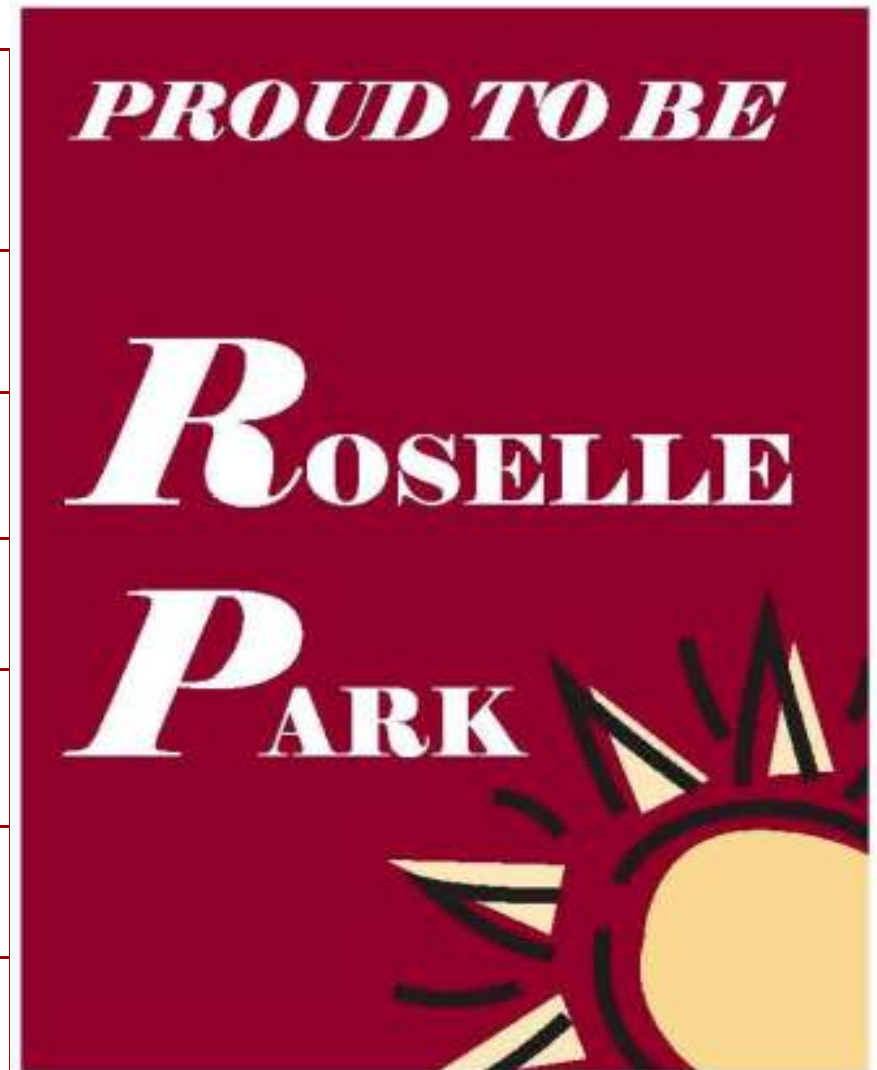

ORDINANCE #28-4 RECYCLING

The passage of New Jersey's mandatory recycling legislation required New Jersey's twenty-one counties to develop recycling plans that mandated the recycling of at least three designated recyclable materials, in addition to leaves.

28-4.1 Residential Separation Program Established.

There is hereby established a program for the mandatory separation of the following recyclable materials from residential solid waste by the occupants of the premises within the Borough and the separate disposal of the same:

- a. Uncontaminated newspapers.
- b. Uncontaminated, clean and unbroken glass containers.
- c. Clean aluminum cans.
- d. Uncontaminated corrugated cardboard.
- e. Clean ferrous (steel) cans.
- f. Uncontaminated, clean polyethylene terephthalate (PET) bottles and high-density polyethylene (HDPE).
- g. Uncontaminated roofing material.
- h. Used motor oil.

Recycling, Vegetative Waste and Trash items shall not be put out before 7:00 P.M. on the night before the pick-up day, except Sundays when trash can be put out at 3:00 P.M.

VOTER REGISTRATION

The last day to register to vote before the November 3, 2009 General Election is Tuesday October 13th from 8:30 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. for voter registration and changes. Voter registrations are accepted at the Borough Clerk's office Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. year round. Please call us at 908-245-6222 if you have any questions.

BULK WASTE: Picked up curbside according to the schedule. Placed in suitable metal, rubber or plastic container and total weight of any container shall not exceed 50 pounds.

No plastic bags.

Maximum 500 pound weight limit per property.

Examples of bulk waste items are furniture, mattresses (limit 2 per residence), toys, storm windows, car tires (without rims), rugs, storm doors, doors, clothing, windows, wood fences, lawn furniture, carpeting and material generated by the homeowner from alterations or repairs;

and **exclude** the following items:

ashes, dirt, tree trunks, stumps, branches, pool filters, car tires with rims, railroad ties, rocks, stones, asphalt, concrete closed-top drums, automobile parts, appliances (refrigerators, washers, dryers, etc.), paint chemicals and material resulting from demolition, alterations or repairs to building not generated by the homeowner.

Be Safe This
Holiday Season



Trees:

- Make sure your tree gets at least 1 gallon of water per inch of trunk diameter. A 6 foot tree can consume 1 gallon of water per day
- Do not place your tree within 3 feet of a fireplace, heating vents or other heat source.

Lighting:

- Look for the UL Mark on lights, decorations and extension cords
- Inspect lights, decorations and extension cords for cracked, frayed or bare or loose wires to avoid electric shock or fire
- Do not overload extension cords
- Turn off lights and decorations before going to bed or leaving your home

Candles:

- Keep candles away from combustible materials, such as decorations, paper and wreaths
- Extinguish candles when leaving the room or going to sleep
