# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q: Who do I call to report a missed pickup?**  
**A:** To report a missed pickup of any kind (garbage, recycling, vegetative waste, or bulk waste) please call the Department of Public Works at 908-245-7676 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, holidays excluded.

**Q: When can I place items/containers curbside?**  
**A:** Garbage, Recycling, and Vegetative Waste may be placed curbside no sooner than 7:00 p.m. the evening prior to a collection date. Bulk Waste may be placed curbside no sooner than 12:00 p.m. the afternoon prior to a collection date.

**Q: Does recycling need to be separated?**  
**A:** YES!!! The Borough utilizes a dual stream system to garner the best market pricing from collection and disposal vendors. Co-Mingled Bottles, Cans and Plastics must be kept separate from Co-Mingled Paper Products.

**Q: What type of containers can I place curbside?**  
**A:** Receptacles not larger than thirty-two (32) gallons equipped with a pull handle(s) which total a loaded weight not exceeding fifty (50) pounds. This does not include bulk waste collection. Plastic bags, in and of themselves, are not to be utilized or considered a container for the purposes of garbage collection. Use of plastic bags is prohibited for the purpose of disposing recycling and vegetative waste.

**Q: What is considered "bulk waste"?**  
**A:** Solid waste including furniture, toys, mattresses (limited 2 per address), wood (limit of two - 32 gallon containers with pieces cut into 3 foot pieces BULK WASTE EXCLUDES: rugs, carpeting, electronic waste, ashes, dirt, tree trunks, stumps, branches, brush, leaves, household garbage, pool filters, railroad ties, rocks, stones, asphalt, concrete, closed-top drums, automobile parts, appliances, paint, chemicals, and materials resulting from demolition, alterations or repairs to buildings or other structures not generated by the homeowner and not generated from pickup sites requiring permits.

Total weight of all items is limited to 500 pounds per address!
