FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Who do I call to report a missed pickup?

A: To report a missed pickup of any kind (garbage, recycling, vegetative waste, or bulk waste) please call the Department of Public Works at 908-245-7676 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, holidays excluded. If you do not get through to an employee, please leave a voicemail with your name, address, and call-back number.

Q: What is bulk waste collection?

A: Bulk waste collection is a service provided by the Borough that allows residents to dispose of larger items that cannot be placed in regular household garbage. The monthly curbside bulk waste collection program may be utilized by residents of single- to four-family structures. Residents of larger complexes with five or more dwelling units should contact the Department of Public Works to inquire about the “a La Carte” pickup service.

Q: What is considered bulk waste?

A: The Borough defines “bulk waste” as indoor or outdoor furniture, toys, mattresses, box springs, wood limited to (32) gallon containers with pieces cut into three-foot sections, storm windows, doors, and various items generated by a homeowner in the scope of minor repairs not requiring a zoning or construction permit.

Bulk **DOES NOT** include carpeting, electronic waste, ashes, dirt, tree trunks, stumps, branches, brush, leaves, household garbage, pool filters, railroad ties, rocks, stones, asphalt, concrete, closed-top drums, automobile parts, appliances, paint, chemicals and material resulting from work requiring zoning or construction permits.

Q: What type of containers can I place curbside?

A: Receptacles not larger than thirty-two (32) gallons equipped with a pull handle(s) which total a loaded weight not exceeding fifty (50) pounds. Uncontained plastic bags, in and of themselves, are not to be utilized or considered a container for the purposes of garbage collection. Use of plastic bags is prohibited for the purpose of disposing bulk waste, recycling, and vegetative waste.

Q: When can items/containers be placed curbside?

A: Garbage, recycling and vegetative waste should be placed curbside after 7PM on the evening before pickup; for Monday collections, containers may be placed curbside anytime after 3PM the afternoon before. Bulk waste should be placed curbside after 12PM on the day before pickup.
